



Drink Spike Test

Q: What substances can the Drink Spike detect?

A: The Drink Spike detector is designed to identify the presence of Gamma Hydroxybutyrate (GHB) and Ketamine in drinks and in concentrations likely to prove to have an effect on the health and welfare of the consumer.

The detector may identify other substances (but not Rohypnol) that may render persons incapacitated when placed in drinks.

Q: What does a positive result mean?

A: A positive test identifies that a drink may contain GHB or Ketamine therefore the drink should not be consumed.

Q: What should I do if my drink has been “spiked”

A: If you think your drink may have been “spiked” then hand it over to someone responsible like the Bar Manager or Security.

Q: What are some of the general guidelines for making sure your drink does not get “spiked”?

A: The most important guidelines for safe drinking are:

- Watch your drink at all times.
- When drinking from a bottle watch it being uncapped.
- Do not let anyone touch the top of your bottled drink.
- Do not consume a drink that has been left unattended
- Always report any suspected “spiked” drink
- Avoid drinks coming from punchbowls
- Try to buy your own drinks
- Try to keep your glass/bottle close to your body at all times and preferably in your hand.
